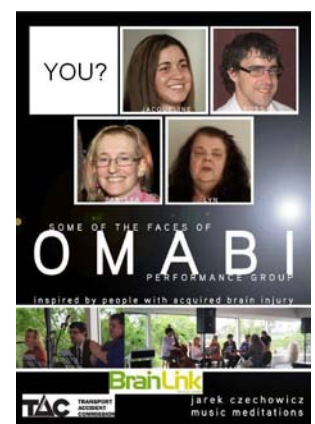

1. **Brain Injury Awareness Week**

The 14th – 20th of September is Brain Injury Awareness Week. The theme for this year is focussed on **Children, Young People and Acquired Brain Injury**. In Australia, there are almost 25,000 children aged 0-14 and 55,000 young people aged 15-24 with a brain injury, and over 10,000 more acquire a brain injury every year – from car or bike accidents, falls, infections and illness, or child abuse. **There are many events happening during the week some of them are:**

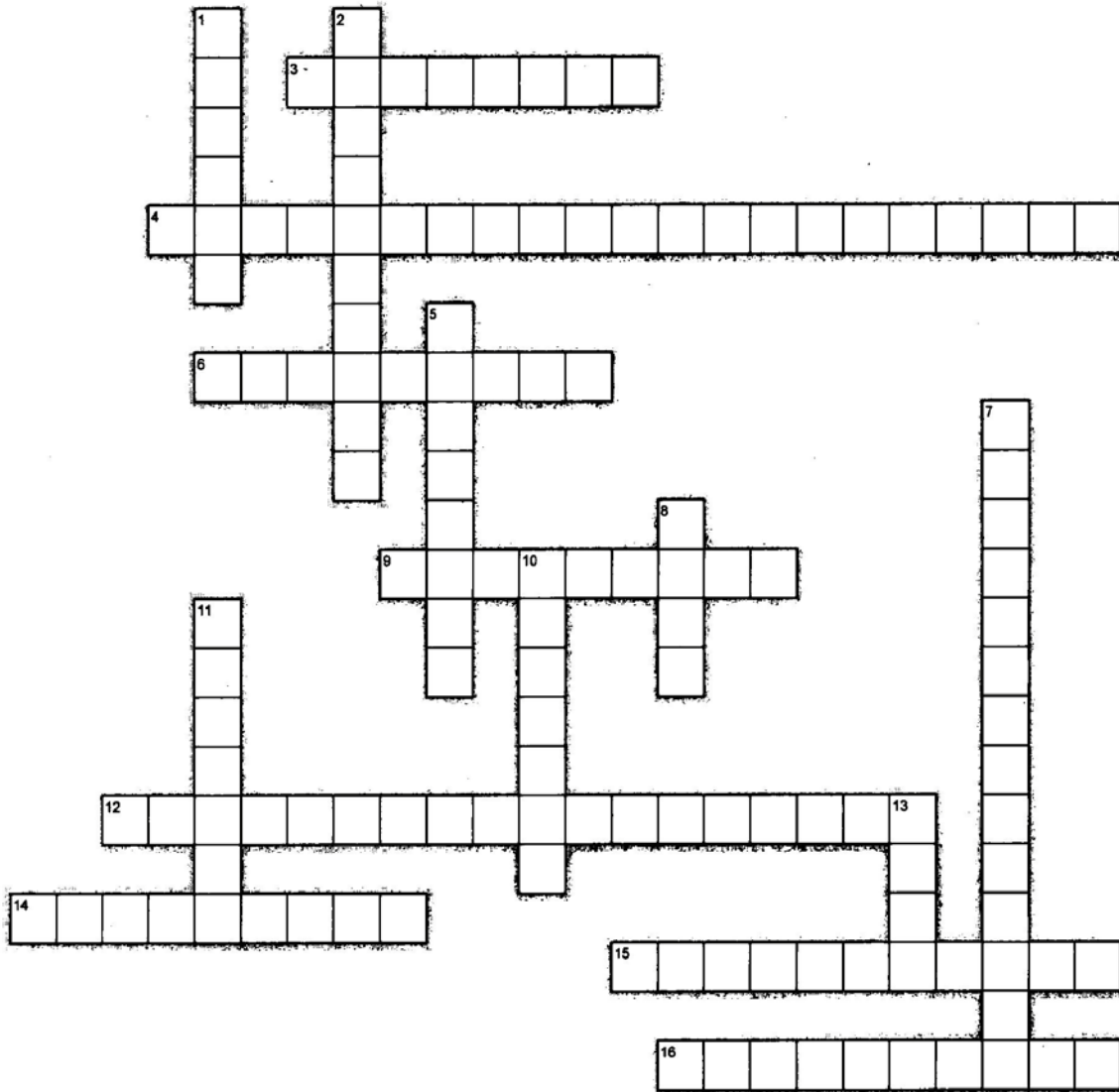
